Building Stronger Neighborhoods, One Street at a Time

Greater Cleveland Habitat for Humanity has been active in the Buckeye and Mount Pleasant neighborhoods since 2016. Rather than spreading efforts across scattered sites, Habitat focuses on concentrated areas to create deeper, more lasting impact. Working in concert with residents, local nonprofits, and companies, Habitat helps drive neighborhood revitalization.

In 2025, we began work on Elwell Avenue — our Pope Leo Village. This street already includes four Habitat families in homes we previously rehabbed, and now we're adding 15 new homes. The project is part of the City of Cleveland's Modular Home Pilot, with six of the ten stick-built homes underway, three modular builds, and three using a panelized system.

our work in buckeye & mount pleasant

- **48 homes rehabbed** in Buckeye and Mount Pleasant
- **100 residents supported** through **critical home repairs**
- **345 residents** engaged through **Spruce-Up volunteer days**
- **40 new homes built** on four consecutive streets




